PARTNERSHIP PRINCIPLES

- ▶ A donor supports capacity, not conclusions. Partners never determine expert findings, data or methodology.
- ▶ Each partnership goes through conflict-of-interest screening and reputational review.
- ▶ Partnership does not mean political favour, endorsement or buying content.
- ▶ For larger private partnerships, FSF applies source-diversification rules; private sponsorship is capped internally at 25 % of total sources.
